Uganda Nurses and Midwives Council (UNMC) is a health professional regulatory and supervisory body under the Ministry of Health, established under the Uganda Nurses and Midwives Act, 1996 (CAP. 274) to set and regulate standards for training and practice of nursing and midwifery professions in Uganda. The Council has the mandate to protect the public from unsafe nursing and midwifery practices; ensure quality of nursing and midwifery services; foster the development of the nursing and midwifery profession; and confer responsibility, accountability, identity, and status of the Nurses/Midwives in Uganda.

In its effort to attain desirable quality standards of nursing and midwifery care, the Council developed CPD guidelines to streamline the implementation of CPD activities for Nurses and Midwives in Uganda. UNMC therefore invites interested, eligible, and competent Institutions, Departments, Health facilities, Professional Associations, Governmental and Non-government Organizations to apply for accreditation as a CPD provider in the following areas:

- Nursing/Midwifery Education
- Public Health Nursing
- Clinical Nursing/Midwifery
- Nursing/Midwifery Leadership and Management
- Nursing/Midwifery Research
- Professionalism and customer care
- Any other relevant specialty

Eligible CPD providers will be those that are accredited by their relevant bodies to offer services in Uganda. Regionally based CPD providers are also encouraged to apply.
